

Bus Drop Off and Parking Information for Schools and Groups

With ongoing construction of the new LRT Valley Line and the Stanley Milner Library construction, parts of 102 Avenue will be closed for the next few years. We recommend dropping off/picking up students at/near the Citadel and parking the bus at a nearby bus parking spot (see below for drop off locations). Please allow yourselves extra travel time in case of any major delays.

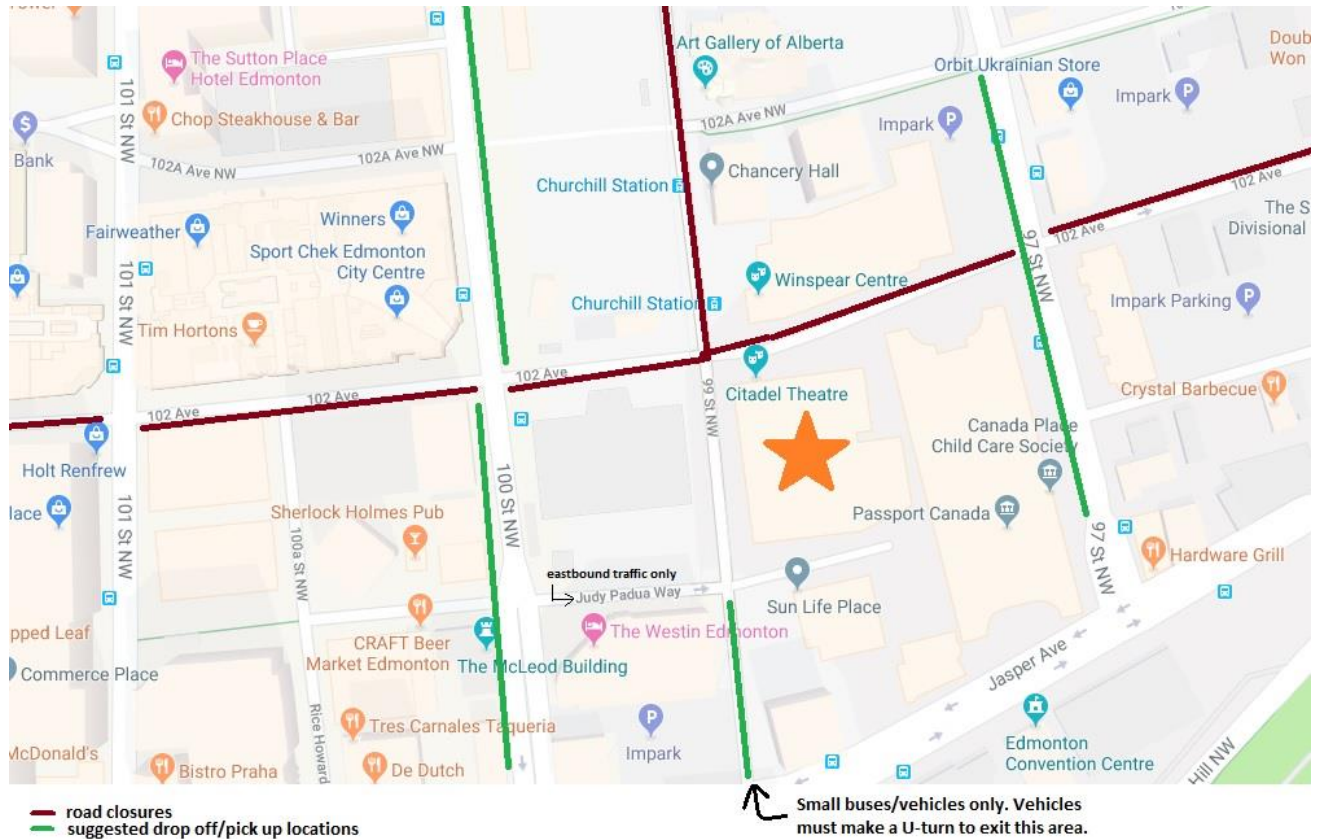

Suggested Bus Drop Off/Pick Up Locations

- **97 Street (southbound) between 102A Avenue and Jasper Avenue.** Students can walk outside to the Citadel Theatre, or enter Canada Place by the entrance on 97 Street and walk through the indoor pedway to the Citadel Theatre.
- **100 Street between 102 Avenue and Jasper Avenue.** If dropping off students from the City Centre Mall, Churchill Square, or the Stanley Milner Library (currently under construction), students will need to walk outside to get to the Citadel. There may be slight pedestrian detours on 102 Avenue.
- **For small buses or regular vehicles only: 99 Street between 101A Avenue and Jasper Avenue.** Due to closed access to 102 Avenue, vehicles will need to do a U-turn to exit 99 Street via Jasper Avenue. An alternative route is to enter the area via 100 Street between the Westin and the Stanley Milner Library. It is a single lane one-way road that is eastbound. You may take this road and turn right (south) onto 99 Street. Again, we recommend smaller vehicles only.
- **NOTE:** Due to busy traffic flow on Jasper Avenue, we do not recommend dropping off or picking up students on Jasper Avenue.



Bus Parking Information

The following downtown tour bus parking stalls are first come first served and can be found at these locations. Please note some spots may be unavailable due to the changing construction schedules.

- Jasper Avenue (South side) West of 97 Street
- MacDonald Drive (South side) West of 101 Street
- MacDonald Drive (North side) east of 101 Street
- 102 Street (East side) North of 100 Avenue
- 104 Street (West side) North of 100 Avenue
- 105 Street (East side) South of 102 Avenue

All of the above locations have signage designating "Tour Bus Parking Only"

If all of these stalls are full you could make a deal with a property manager of a local shopping mall or similar arrangement.

It can be arranged through The City of Edmonton to have parking meters hooded/EPark Zones reserved but this needs to be done a few days in advance and there is a fee for this service.
