How many guests can I have?

As per current government restrictions, we are limiting attendance to 100 of your favourite people, socially distanced of course!

How long is the booking?

Each booking includes a total of 2.5 hours for set-up, ceremony, and strike. Need more time? No problem! Contact our Events team at events@citadeltheatre.com to discuss options.

How much does it cost?

The Garneau Block Set Package starts at \$1600+GST and includes:

- Exclusive access to the Maclab Stage for 2.5 hours
- Socially-distanced seating for up to 100 guests
- An event supervisor for wedding duration
- A sound system with microphone
- Directional building signage
- A sound and audio technician for event duration
- The once in a lifetime opportunity to get married on a set!

Can I have a rehearsal?

As we are a union house theatre, we do need to call in our fabulous crew each time the space is booked. If you wish to have rehearsal the day before, we offer a special rate of \$255/hr with a minimum of 2 hours.

Will the set be lit like it is in the video?

Absolutely!

Does this package come with any other wedding décor? Can I bring my own?

With a set this gorgeous, who needs extra décor?! We kindly ask couples to refrain from additional décor.

How can you guarantee everything is clean and sanitized? Will sanitizer or masks be provided?

The Citadel is following all government regulations and restrictions as they arise. We will ensure the space is cleaned and disinfected before each event, and will provide hand sanitizer at each entrance. The Citadel strongly recommends all guests to practice social distancing, proper hygiene, and to stay home when feeling ill. All attendees are required to wear masks as per the City of Edmonton's mandate regarding indoor spaces, in effect August 1. Exemptions can be made for participants

Our staff will be present to aid and consult in ensuring the mandate is followed properly for the safety of your party and the other people in our space. Attendees without masks may not be permitted into the building as per the Citadel's compliance with the mandate.

Is there a space for myself and bridal party to get ready?

Unfortunately, due to COVID-19 we have limited access to spaces. Because of this, we ask you to be dressed and ready to get married upon arrival.

Is the stage wheelchair accessible?

Yes! Please inform your Event Coordinator in advance of an individual(s) who may require extra assistance.

Can we have food and beverage?

At this time, the Citadel is not permitting outside food. However, our amazing bar staff would be happy to assist you with beverage options such as a champagne toast. Please reach out to our Events team to inquire.

Other Important Information:

- 100-person guest count must include the couple getting married, the marriage commissioner, the photographer, videographer, and all guests.
- The Citadel does not provide a photographer, videographer, or marriage commissioner. These are the couple's responsibility.
- All weddings must follow the COVID-19 guidelines set by the Government of Alberta.
- The Citadel encourages all guest to practice social distancing, proper hygiene and stay home when feeling ill.

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
